Christopher Rogers, Scoutmaster

Chris became Scoutmaster of Troop 507 Winchester in 2000 after serving as an Assistant Scoutmaster for two years. Prior to SM he served as Cubmaster of Pack 507 for several years along with positions of Den Leader and Tiger Coach. Chris is a member of the Fox patrol member in this spring's Wood Badge Course NE-I-261, has Scoutmaster Fundamental training and holds current SOLO Wilderness First Aid and CPR/AED certifications. Chris received Flintlock District Award of Merit in 2008 and the God & Service Recognition Award from BSA & United Methodist Church in 2006. Chris's prior mountain top adventures include his hiking treks to Philmont Scout Ranch in 2008 & 2006, a Northern Tier, Ely, MN canoe trek in 2007, and attending National Jamborees in 2001 and 2005 as Scoutmaster, for the Boston Minuteman Council. As a youth in the Louis Agassiz Fuertes Council in upstate New York, Chris attained Eagle Scout, became Brotherhood member with Order of the Arrow. He attended the 1969 National Jamboree, Coeur d'Alene, ID as a JASM.



Steve Sookikian, 1st Assistant Scoutmaster

Steve Sookikian became Scoutmaster of Troop 248 Waltham in June 2006 after serving as Assistant Scoutmaster during the 2005-2006 Scout year. He completed Scoutmastership Fundamentals Plus training in Spring 2006, and completed Wilderness First Aid training in March 2008. He is currently a Buffalo Patrol member of Wood Badge Course NE-I-261. Steve also served as a Philmont Crew Advisor in July 2008. In 2007, he became a Brotherhood member of the Order of the Arrow Moswetuset Lodge, and attends summer camp each year with the troop at T. L. Storer. He joined the troop committee in the fall of 2004, and sits on Eagle Boards of Review. He also serves as merit badge counselor for Communications, Public Speaking, Journalism, and Pioneering. As a youth, Sookikian attained the rank of Eagle Scout in 1974 with Troop 222 Watertown. An Ordeal member of the Taskiagi Lodge, he earned BSA Scout Life Guard, and served on summer camp staff at Camp Schem (Antrim, N.H.) in 1974 as Provisional Troop Assistant Scoutmaster. Also as a youth, he hiked Philmont as the Crew Chief in 1972 and attended the National Jamboree in 1973 at Moraine State Park in Pennsylvania. Sookikian served as District Finance Chairman from 2007 to 2009, and as a member of the Council Finance Committee from 2005 to the present.

Marti started his scouting in Troop 212 in Iowa City, Iowa where he became an Eagle Scout in 1977. 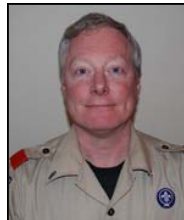
Stephen Bosak, Scoutmaster
